

Driver Education Data

Distance

- 57 Children should be 57 inches tall or 7 years old to wear a shoulder harness
 - 15ft Car from a fire hydrant
 - 20ft Crosswalk
 - 20ft Distance from a fire station on the same side of the road
 - 25ft Front and behind a school bus with flashing red lights
(Except a divided highway)
 - 30ft Vehicle stopped by brakes at 20 mph to pass inspection
 - 30ft From intersection with a stop sign or traffic light
 - 15'-50' Must stop for RR tracks with a stop sign or flashing red lights
 - 50ft Parking distance from RR tracks
 - 75ft Parking distance from a fire station on opposite side of road
 - 100ft Directional before turn
 - 100ft No passing before a viaduct, tunnel, intersection, or RR crossing
 - 200ft Place flares in front of/behind and accident scene
 - 100ft Range of low beams
 - 150ft Dim lights in front or behind another vehicle
 - 200ft Must be seen in either direction when parked on side of road
 - 200ft Horn must be heard this distance to pass inspection
 - 200ft Clearance when passing task is completed
 - 350ft Range of high beams
 - 500ft Following fire apparatus responding to an alarm
 - 500ft Signal before a turn on an open highway
 - 2/32 Minimum tread depth for inspection

- 10 MPH BELOW SPEED LIMIT school zone 45 min. before/after school
 - 30 MPH Business or urban residence district
 - 35 MPH Rural residence district
 - 35 MPH Car may begin hydroplaning
 - 45 MPH Maximum speed towing a house trailer
 - 45 MPH Minimum speed on an interstate
 - 55 MPH All others including interstate highways not otherwise posted
 - 65 MPH Specific sections of interstate highways where posted
 - Headlights must be turned on ½ hour after sunset, ½ hour before sunrise
