Tuition Refund

A student may be dropped from the Jump Start Drivers Education, LLC Driver Education course and tuition will be nonrefundable for any of the following reasons:

- Missing more than 4 hours. Any absences must be for good cause and parents must provide written documentation explaining any absence. Despite any absences, student must attain at least 30 classroom hours, at least 10 Driving hours, and at least 6 attentive Driving Observation hours.
- 2. Creating a behavior problem before, during or after class. Non-cooperation or a display of non-preparation for lessons may also lead to the student being dropped.
- 3. Terminating an in-car lesson by the instructor any time a question of safety exists. Only a reasonable suspicion of alcohol or other drug influence is necessary to end a lesson.
- 4. NO REFUND after second class attended.
- 5. No cell phone use during class. All phones must be powered down and placed under the desk face down upon entering classroom.

Incomplete Course

If a student has to withdraw due to illness or extenuating circumstances, the student shall be allowed to resume a like course from the point at which he/she had completed if it is:

- 1. Within 6 months from the date of the last class attended in the original course in the same school; or
- 2. Within 6 months from the date of the last class attended in the original program, in a different school, provided that he/she receives a letter from the original program attesting to the following:
 - a. The student's achievement;
 - b. Number of classroom hours completed;
 - c. Number of behind-the-wheel hours completed; and
 - d. Number of observation hours completed.
