

Driver Education Parent Expectations

Parents/guardians are aware of and understand the following expectations for successful completion of the driver education course provided by Jump Start Drivers Education, LLC.

1. Parents/guardians understand that all registration and permission forms will be signed and delivered to the instructor as instructed on the web site, no later than Parent Night.
2. Parents/guardians will assist their son/daughter/new driver in completing assigned projects to enhance communication and to foster learning opportunities outside of driver education. Each of the projects will be signed and dated as indicated on the projects.
3. Parents/guardians understand that forty (40) hours of at home practice is required by the state prior to applying for a license. Ten (10) of those hours must take place between one half hour after sunset and one half hour before sunrise.
4. Parents/guardians understand that at home practice is crucial for student progress during the course. Parents/guardians understand that if the instructor determines that the student has not mastered a skill necessary to progress to the next driving skill they will provide documentation of at home practice before the students resumes driving with Jump Start Drivers Education, LLC.

In-car driving instruction is scheduled individually by the instructor. Driving times will be available during and after school, some evenings, and some weekends. Students should get roughly 1-2 hours per week of driving time with the instructor, depending on the length of the course.

Students must complete 16 projects throughout the course. These projects are due as requested by the instructor. In addition to these assignments, students must also complete an additional homework sheet pertaining to the number of behind-the-wheel hours they have completed. Assignments due must be handed in at the beginning of the designated class. Failure to complete any assignment by the due date will result in an additional assignment for that day. By law, students are allowed to miss a total of 4 hours (2 classes) for any reason, as long as they satisfactorily complete the minimum requirements of at least 30 or more hours in the classroom, 10 or more hours of driving, and 6 or more hours of alert observation. Therefore, absences that result from non-preparation will greatly affect the student's ability to successfully complete the driver education course.

Students will take multiple exams and short quizzes during the driver education course. There are unit exams, and 2 final exams. Students must complete the course with an average of at least 80. Students must score at least an 80 on both of the finals. One make up per final exam will be allowed. Students must also hand in their course notebook as listed on the classroom schedule. Please note that students are responsible for all material covered in class, even if they are absent.

Students who fail to comply with the requirements listed above will not pass the course and must retake the course at full cost. There is no guarantee of success; however, students who apply themselves and follow the guidelines for the course should have no problems passing. Remember that driving in NH is a privilege and not a right. Students must demonstrate maturity and responsibility in order to obtain a license. Finally, cooperation between the instructor, student and parent is critical for success. Any problems/issues should be addressed in a timely manner so they can be dealt with adequately. Tuition Refund OR Incomplete Course

Tuition Refund

A student may be dropped from the Jump Start Drivers Education, LLC Driver Education course and tuition will be nonrefundable for any of the following reasons:

1. Missing more than 4 hours. Any absences must be for good cause and parents must provide written documentation explaining any absence. Despite any absences, student must attain at least 30 classroom hours, at least 10 Driving hours, and at least 6 attentive Driving Observation hours.
2. Creating a behavior problem before, during or after class. Non-cooperation or a display of non-preparation for lessons may also lead to the student being dropped.
3. Terminating an in-car lesson by the instructor any time a question of safety exists. Only a reasonable suspicion of alcohol or other drug influence is necessary to end a lesson.
4. **NO REFUND after second class attended.**
5. No cell phone use during class. All phones must be powered down and placed under the desk face down upon entering classroom.

Incomplete Course

If a student has to withdraw due to illness or extenuating circumstances, the student shall be allowed to resume a like course from the point at which he/she had completed if it is:

1. Within 6 months from the date of the last class attended in the original course in the same school; or
2. Within 6 months from the date of the last class attended in the original program, in a different school, provided that he/she receives a letter from the original program attesting to the following:
 - a. The student's achievement;
 - b. Number of classroom hours completed;
 - c. Number of behind-the-wheel hours completed; and
 - d. Number of observation hours completed.

By law, students are allowed to miss a total of 4 hours (2 classes) for any reason, as long as they satisfactorily complete the minimum requirements of at least 30 or more hours in the classroom, 10 or more hours of driving, and 6 or more hours of alert observation. Therefore, absences that result from non-preparation will greatly affect the student's ability to successfully complete the course. Students who fail to complete the requirements must pay to re-take the course.
